

## Intent for Bursary Applications For Year 2026

The school partners a few charitable organisations to provide bursaries for needy students from families whose gross monthly household income does not meet the MOE-Financial Assistance Scheme (MOE-FAS) criteria.

Your child may be recommended to apply for these bursaries if the conditions below are met:

- a) Your child is a Singapore Citizen or Singapore Permanent Resident.
- b) Your child is **not** a recipient of the MOE- FAS.
- c) The gross monthly household income for your family is between \$4,001 - \$5,500 or the per capita income for your household is between \$1,001 - \$1,375 per month.

If your child meets the above criteria and you wish to apply for the bursaries, please complete and submit the attached Application Form to the school through your child's Form Teacher **by Monday, 12 January 2026**.

Should there be bursaries made available by the organisations within the year, the school will issue a letter with the organisation's application forms to your child. Additional information on the submission procedures, deadlines and any documents required by the organisations will also be provided.

Please note the bursaries disbursed from these organisations **are not guaranteed**. Additional conditions which **must also be met** are shown below:

- a) Availability of the bursaries from the various organisations.
- b) Fulfillment of the criteria set by the organisations disbursing the bursaries.
- c) Recommendations by your child's Form Teachers and your child's / ward's conduct (eg your child's punctuality, learning attitude and behavior)
- d) Fully and accurately completed application forms together with all documents required by the organisations must be submitted by the stipulated deadlines given.

This form is also available at the School's website should any child become eligible to apply for the bursaries within the year.
